

## SPLASH PADS

## OPERATING DATES AND TIMES

Open May 4 through Oct. 7  
Open from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m.

\*Splash pads may be closed due to water restrictions, maintenance protocols, or weather related events.

To activate the splash pads:

**Embree Park:** Touch the orange bollard pole with handprint on it to start the water features

**Wynne Park:** Touch the gray bollard pole with handprint on it to start the water features



**Watson Park:** Touch the blue bollard pole with yellow top and green handprint on it to start the water features

**Downtown Square:** Touch the gray bollard pole with green handprint on it to start the water features

## Splash Pad Rules

In order to make your splash pad visit as enjoyable as possible, please observe the following:

- Do not drink water from the water feature.
- Changing diapers within 6-feet of the water feature is prohibited.
- Use of water feature when ill with diarrhea is prohibited.
- Use of water feature when ill with a contagious disease is prohibited.
- Non-service animals prohibited.
- No glass containers allowed on splash pad.
- No bicycles, skateboards, or skates allowed on the splash pad.
- Water shoes are strongly recommended.
