
## **Policy**



It is the policy of the City of Garland Parks and Recreation Department (GPARD) that the Managing Director or designee, in partnership with the Garland Police Department, attend community events for the purpose of informing and educating the community on matters related to laws, ordinances, polices and safety in Garland parks, trails, events, open spaces and sporting events.

GPARD staff are encouraged to attend the following types of community meetings as requested or self initiated: Neighborhood Association Meetings, Crime Watch groups, non-profit groups, Council member town halls, National Night Out, Community Leaders Group monthly meetings, booths at special events, Citizen Police Academy, Library programs or other similar community gathering opportunities.

When staff are contacted by a Council member to attend or present during Town Halls or other community events, the Managing Director shall be responsible for preparing presentation materials, hand-outs, exhibits, etc. one week in advance to the requesting Council member for their review and approval.
